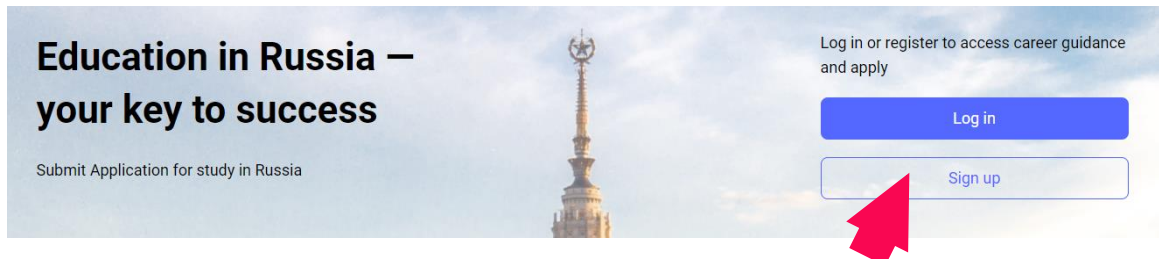

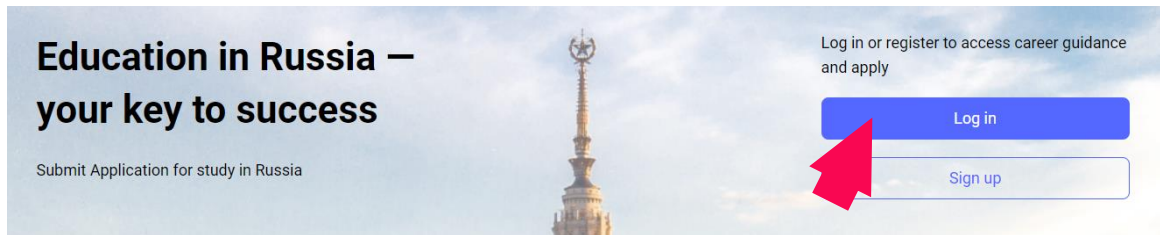

Upload the passport with which you plan to enter Russia. The passport should expire no earlier than one and a half years after entering Russia

You need to upload a document with the most significant educational level. If the document on education has not yet been received, then you should download the report card or transcript of progress, or academic transcript. Uploading a notarized translation will be required if you are selected to study in the Russian Federation

This document is needed if you are applying for postgraduate (adjunct) programs. The topic of the abstract must correspond to the direction selected within the application

Medical certificate of the established form about the absence of contraindications for studying in Russia

A medical certificate can be issued in your country. The main thing is that it is valid in Russia (translated and certified) and meets the requirements of your university. In some cases, the certificates provided when applying for a study visa may be suitable. Also, a certificate can be made upon arrival in the Russian Federation (form 086). For details, check with the international departments of universities.

A medical certificate of the established sample on the absence of contraindications for studying in Russia with a note on the results of an HIV test (or a medical certificate)

Residence in the past on the territory of the Russian state, the Russian republic, the RSFSR, the USSR or the Russian Federation, the corresponding citizenship when leaving this territory and the citizenship or lack thereof at the time of presentation - for immigrants (emigrants)

Relationship in a straight ascending line with the indicated persons - for the descendants of compatriots

Accommodation abroad - for all specified persons

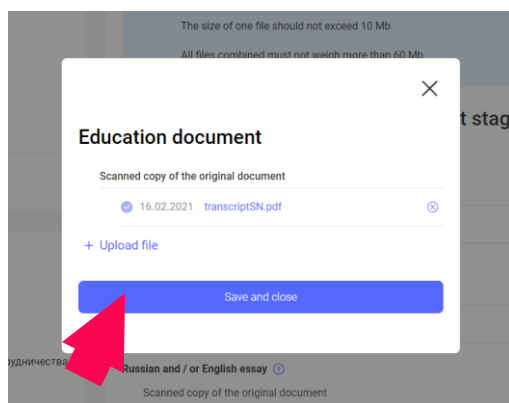

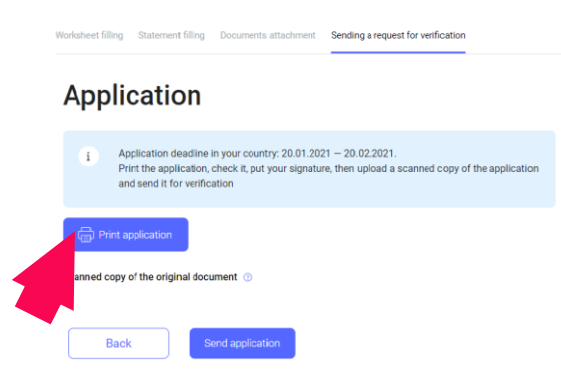

If you filled in all necessary fields and uploaded all necessary documents, you can finish your application. Click “Print application”, sign your application, scan your signed application.

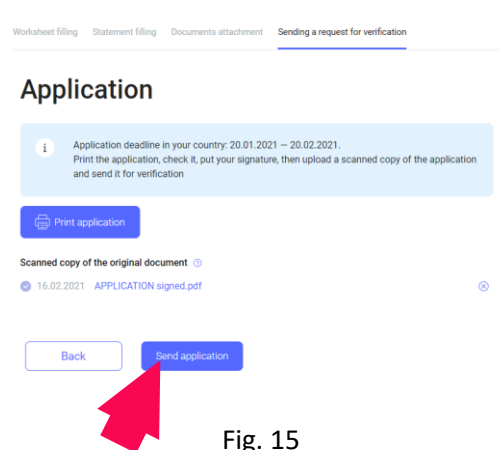

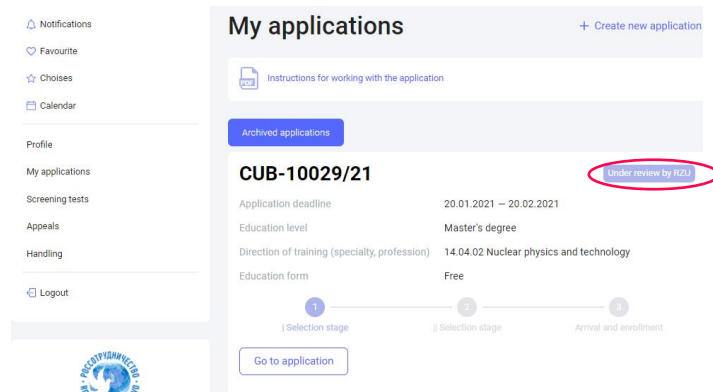
